## **MAYDAY EMERGENCY CALL**

in case of grave and imminent danger to vessel or persons such as fire, sinking, man over board (MOB), etc.

- 1. Make sure VHF radio is switched on
- 2. Open cover **RED** distress button
- 3. Press RED distress button once and release
- 4. Scroll to relevant distress message (Fire, Sinking, MOB, etc.)
- 5. Press and hold the RED distress button for 5 seconds to send the alert\*
- 6. Wait no more than 15 seconds for the acknowledgement (shown on VHF screen) and send the following voice message on VHF 16
