

MAYDAY EMERGENCY CALL

in case of grave and imminent danger to vessel or persons
such as fire, sinking, man over board (MOB), etc.

1. Make sure VHF radio is switched on
2. Open cover **RED** distress button
3. Press **RED** distress button once and release
4. Scroll to relevant distress message (Fire, Sinking, MOB, etc.)
5. Press and hold the **RED** distress button for 5 seconds to send the alert*
6. Wait no more than 15 seconds for the acknowledgement (shown on VHF screen) and send the following voice message on VHF 16
